One Day Dementia Training – 1 Day Face to Face or 2 half days online

This course is open to all health, social care and wider public services staff in Gloucestershire, including the voluntary and independent sector, and people who are caring for a person with dementia.

The course supports a person to gain knowledge and skills when supporting people with dementia, including the changing brain, person centred language and communication approaches. It aims to build on the skills and techniques that the participant has, and will be using when supporting people with dementia, and their carer's.

Dementia Link Worker (DLW) Award & Dementia Lead Award (DL) Course Length – 11 weeks - one day a week

Both the DLW and DL course workshops runs alongside each other and the focus of the Awards is to be able to apply theory to practice in the workplace, applying and role modelling person centred language & approaches when supporting people with dementia and their carer's.

DLW Award – You will be asked to evidence ways you have used knowledge and skills from the workshops back into your area of practice in order to complete the DLW Award.

DL Award – Is open to anyone in a position of leadership within their organisation such as clinical leads, managers, commissioners etc. You will be asked to put forward an action plan which outlines an idea to make a change that will improve the lives of people with dementia and/or the people who support them who access your service, in collaboration with others that you work with.

For both DLW & DL – a keen interest in dementia is essential, plus completion of Tier 1 and /or Tier 2 as above

Train the Trainer (for DLWs & DL's) – 2 days course

This is only offered to those people who have achieved the DL or DLW Award as above. It is designed for people who are comfortable with delivering training to others and who would like to develop their confidence in delivering dementia awareness training. The opportunity to deliver dementia awareness training needs to be available within their organisation. Participants are provided with training resources and the workshop is followed by an observation of the participant's delivery of *Understanding Dementia* in their workplace.
