### **Purpose of role**

### **Key responsibilities**

To provide safe, reliable, compassionate care and support; meeting the individual needs and wishes of all. Each person is unique therefore you must respect everyone's choice about how their care and support is given and promote their dignity at all times.

You will be working as part of a team where you will be supporting individuals to lead fulfilling and independent lives.

You could possibly work in one of the following settings:

- Supported living
- Residential home
- Home care (supporting those in their own homes)
- Nursing home

### **Duties to include**

- To participate in the day-to-day implementation of individual support plans, and activities. Including the delivery of personal care where needed.
- To maintain effective communication and liaison with individuals, families and other key partners whilst respecting appropriate confidentiality.
- To support customers with a variety of tasks such as; the preparation of meals, assisting with medication, laundry duties, cleaning etc.
- To maintain accurate notes and records as and when required.
- To work as part of a team to provide high quality care.

### **Successful candidates will have:**

- The ability to keep calm under pressure.
- Confidence to work alone and as part of a team.
- Excellent communication skills.
- The passion to work with vulnerable Adults.
- The desire and commitment to achieve high standards of safeguarding.

Experience is not essential as training will be provided as well as support.
